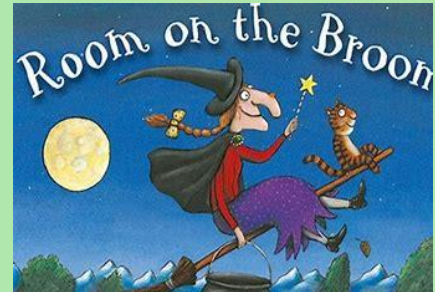
A reminder that children should wear black school shoes / boots every day. This ensures everyone looks smart and feels part of our school community.

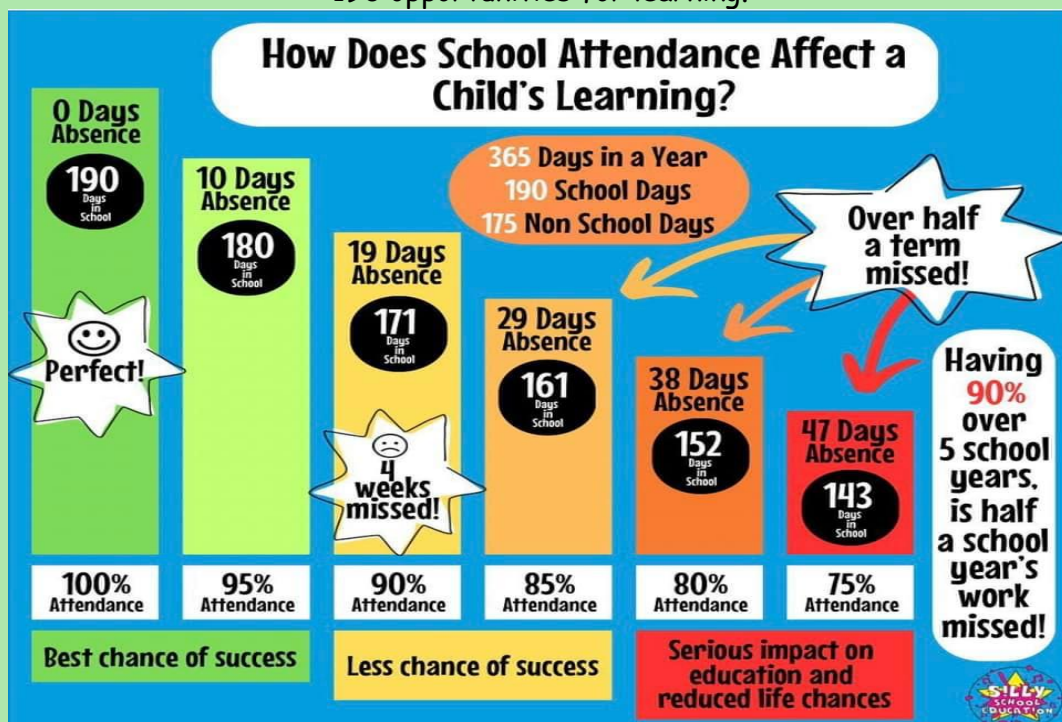
Attendance
